Hazard: - Contaminated water e.g. leptospirosis (weils disease), tentanus, e.coli Reasonably Foreseeable Accident: - Ingestion or absorption of dirty water Worst Case Injury: Infection with E.coli, Leptospirosis, tetanus	LOW (1)	 Leader to warn group about Leptospirosis – contact GP and alert they have been exposed to river water if they experience flu-like symptoms after event (fever, or feel hot and shivery, headache, nausea, aching muscles & joints, red eyes, loss of appetite) All cuts to be covered with waterproof dressing Any cuts received during activity to be cleaned with sterile wipe and covered with waterproof dressing immediately Clean hands immediately after activity (anti-bac gel provided) and any time before eating / drinking / smoking.
